Financial Information 2010-2011

Registrations: This needs to be turned in with the admission application. This fee is non-refundable at any time, unless acceptance is denied.

Materials Fee: This is a yearly fee of \$250 due August 1 of each year.

Tuitions: Monthly tuition payments are due on the first day of each month. These payments are divided over ten months, September through June. Payments may be mailed or dropped off in the school office in the box marked tuition.

-Full-year payment discount: A 5% discount will be applied to tuition which is paid in full by August 1st.

All fees non-refundable: The school contracts with teachers and staff to pay them a set amount for the year regardless of any reduction in student population. The financial agreement between the school and enrolled families is a year-long commitment, even if a student withdraws mid-year.

Donations/Gifts: Tuitions cover about 70% of the cost of educating a student at Island Christian Academy. The remainder is raised through fundraising. We have an auction held in November which parents are required to participate.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

The following is the foundation of beliefs on which Island Christian Academy is based. They are also the key elements of Christianity that will be unapologetically taught in various ways through all grade levels. The substance of these statements is that which will be considered primary doctrine in Island Christian Academy. Secondary or divisive doctrines and issues will not be presented as primary doctrine. When these types of doctrine or issues arise they will be referred back to the family and local churches for final authority.

1. We believe the Bible to be the only inerrant, authoritative Word of God.
2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is omnipotent, omniscient, and omnipresent.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful men, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary.
5. We believe that salvation is by grace through faith alone.
6. We believe that faith without works is dead.
7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.
8. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, they that are saved to the resurrection of life and they that are lost to the resurrection of damnation.
9. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
